A very mild winter in 2004, featuring much lower than average rainfall, led to an extremely early bud-break and nicely controlled vine growth due to low soil moisture levels. The mellow nature of the 2004 harvest was punctuated by a heat wave in early September when temperatures peaked at 105°F, record heat for the “cool” Edna Valley. This gave a final push to the grapes achievement of their optimal ripeness and maturity.

Tasting Notes: Dense and concentrated, with cardamom spice on the nose, accented with jammy black berry, ollieberry, and strawberry. The silky mid palette coats the deepest recesses of your mouth while the wafting aromatic perfume heightens the great acidity and richly textured finish.
